The project HOPES (Higher and Further Education Opportunities and Perspectives for Syrians) is launching its second round of Call for Proposals (CfP) to support innovative education initiatives and short-term projects targeting refugees from Syria and vulnerable host communities across Egypt, Northern Iraq (KRI), Jordan, Lebanon, Turkey and Syria and implemented by local institutions.

ABOUT HOPES

HOPES is a 12€ million project funded by the European Union's Regional Trust Fund in response to the Syrian Crisis, the 'Madad Fund', and implemented by the German Academic Exchange Service (DAAD), British Council, Campus France and Nuffic.

It aims at significantly improving the situation of refugees of post-secondary age from Syria and young people in host communities affected by the high influx of refugees, by directly addressing their education needs.

ABOUT THE CALL FOR PROPOSALS

- > The objective of the CfP is to increase the number of refugees of post-secondary age (between 18 and 32 years) from Syria as well as young people in host communities, that are enrolled and trained in higher education programmes and training courses including innovative further education options and language courses.
- It also seeks to enhance the education and training institutions' capacity to deal with the specific situation of refugees and provide Syrian and vulnerable youth from the host communities, with opportunities to access further and higher education.
- Furthermore, it aims to promote refugee education through better access to online resources, innovative courses and educational support.
- The CfP encourages projects that contribute to enhancing the social cohesion between refugees from Syria and the host communities.

> WHO CAN APPLY?

Through this Call for Proposals, a maximum of 14 projects will be funded in Egypt, Northern Iraq (KRI), Jordan, Lebanon and Turkey and/or Syria.

Local institutions can request funds for their actions ranging from 6,000€ to 60,000€ for a maximum duration of 12 months.

> HOW TO APPLY?

The second round of the Call is now open until the 20th of February 2018.
