

Having a compete vaccine schedule and obtaining the health pass (pass sanitaire) after receiving vaccinations abroad

Covaxin, Sinopharm*, Sinovac* (Recognised by the WHO)	Complete	YES, 1 dose of the mRNA vaccine**
	Incomplete	YES, 2 doses of the mRNA vaccine with 21 to 49 days between the doses**
Sputnik and others (Not recognised by the EMA or the WHO)	Complete or incomplete	YES, 2 doses of the mRNA vaccine with 21 to 49 days between the doses**
* - Sinopharm (Beijing Institute of Biological Products): SARS-CoV- 2 vaccine (Vero Cell), Inactivated (InCoV) - Sinovac: COVID-19 vaccine (Vero Cell), Inactivated/Coronavac™		** 4 weeks after the last vaccine injection received abroad or, otherwise, as soon as possible with Pfizer-BioNTech vaccine or Moderna vaccine. Pfizer-BioNTech vaccine is recommended for the people aged under 30.

If you receive one or more additional doses in France, your health pass will be valid 7 days after the last injection of the mRNA vaccine.
