Campus France brings together a delegation of French higher education institutions at the NAFSA global conference (United States) in late May



Three years after the last in-person gathering, Campus France will participate in the 2022 NAFSA* Annual Conference and Expo in Denver, Colorado from May 31 to June 3. In celebration of 20 years of NAFSA participation, the French Pavilion brings together more than 100 representatives from 34 French universities and higher education institutions.

Hosted in Denver, a dynamic city of over 700,000 residents, the 2022 NAFSA Annual Conference and Expo is the first major opportunity for in-person networking and exchange for higher education institutions around the world since the onset of the public health crisis.

Each year, the conference welcomes more than **10,000 professionals** from across the globe and exhibitors from more than **100 countries**.

NAFSA 2022: “Building Our Sustainable Future”

This year, NAFSA invites participants to **build a sustainable future**. How might we support the evolution of teaching and learning methodologies? How might we design systems that are not only more inclusive, but also more sustainable? How might we adapt student mobility in the context of a profound reimagining of the liberal arts model of United States higher education?

Conferences, workshops, and roundtables will create space for collective reflection and synergies of higher education stakeholders from around the world.

This year's conference is an opportunity for the French delegation to identify new pathways for collaboration and to put forth **ambitious perspectives for the future of French higher education**.

To conclude the conference, and to celebrate 20 years of France's participation at the NAFSA Annual Conference, Campus France and the Embassy of France in the United States invite 400 French higher education stakeholders and their partners to a **French Reception** at the **Ellie Caulkins Opera House in Denver** on June 2 from 7pm to 9pm.
