CAEN

Founded in 1432, Université de Caen Normandie (UNICAEN) is among Europe's 10 oldest universities. The university enrolls some 30,000 students on several campuses in Caen and other regionally implated campuses (Alençon, Cherbourg-Octeville, Lisieux, Saint-Lô, and Vire). Each of Unicaen campuses makes modern equipment available to students, enhancing students' quality of life and opportunities for academic success.

RESEARCH

Twenty-one of UNICAEN's 45 research units are affiliated with national research organizations such as CNRS, INSERM, CEA, INRA, and IFREMER. The University research efforts, organized in three multidisciplinary clusters, bring together all major academic partners in Caen: among them are Ecole Nationale Supérieure d'Ingénieurs (ENSICAEN), the national heavy ion accelerator (GANIL), CYCERON (a neuroscience imaging platform), the University hospital, and François Baclesse regional cancer center. A center for research in humanities and ICORE (a superinstitute for research on cells' interactions assist in the management of Unicaen research efforts.

RENNES

The Université de Rennes 1, which has its roots in the 15th century, is one of the twelve main French universities. Located in the heart of a city on a human scale, it is only an hour and a half from Paris. The quality of its research and its links with the socio-economic world have made it an internationally recognised university. It has 17 IRP (International Research Projects, ex-LIA), 4 IRN (International Research Networks), 150 international agreements and more than 200 Erasmus The university has 19 agreements. departments (10 Faculties, 1 IPAG, 1 IGR-IAE, 4 IUT, 2 Engineering Schools, 1 Observatory of the Sciences of the Universe) with 30,000 students, of which 10% are international students. It offers degrees taught entirely in English in the fields of chemistry, environmental sciences, computer science, economics and management. Since 2019, it has been part of the European Digital UniverCity (EDUC) alliance, one of the first universities selected by the European Commission.

The University of Strasbourg has a history spanning five centuries adorned with famous names, and a rich heritage.

'Our excellence, your future'The excellence of the University of Strasbourg is recognised on a national and international level by the award of the Excellence Initiative label (IdEx). This funding program allows the University to benefit from special funds to finance innovative projects (scholarships, student-athlete status, navigation aid for the visually impaired, etc.) for the benefit of the entire university community.



Switzerland and France, and close to several major cities and airports accessible by road or by train: 45 minutes from the Basel / Mulhouse airport, 1h45 from the airport International Zurich (Switzerland) by road at 2:30 from Frankfurt (Germany) International Airport by road, at 2:20 by train from Paris, 200 km from Lyon. The area of Belfort-Montbéliard-hericourt is the first most industrial employment area in France, with for example the automotive industry: Peugeot Citroen (2nd car manufacturer), Faurecia, the Transport industry: Alstom Transport (highspeed TGV), the energy industry: GE energy Products, Alstom Power,.... UTBM is in the heart of this region, located in the Technology center of Belfort, with a dynamic work environment and an excellent quality of life.

COMPIÈGNE

Université de Technologie de Compiègne (UTC), founded in 1972 as a new kind of public institution, combines the concept of a traditional university with that of a grande école specializing in engineering. UTC has an enrollment of 4,500, a faculty of 450, and an administrative and technical staff of 400. It is consistently ranked among the best engineering programs in France. UTC's international orientation attracts students from every continent. Dedicated support services and special programs help international students adjust quickly to life at UTC.

research (IRT), and a corporation specializing in accelerated technology transfer (SATT).
